

# Terminators Pest Control

## Bed Bug Treatment featuring **CRYONITE**

### **Preparation Checklist:**

- Strip all beds of sheets, pillowcases, shams, mattress pads, blankets, bed skirts/dust ruffles and blankets. Put thru dryer on highest temperature for a least 1 hour including pillows, and place in sealed plastic bags.
- Remove all items from bedroom closets. Put clothing thru dryer on highest heat for 1 hour, and place in an unused plastic bag and seal tightly. If articles are dry clean only, take to the dry cleaners, may be advisable to leave these items at Cleaners until treatment is done.
- Remove all items from dresser drawers, nightstands and dressing tables. Put thru dryer on highest temperature for 1 hours and place in sealed plastic bags.
- Remove all shoes from shoe boxes, wipe the inside of the shoes or vacuum and place in a sealed plastic bag. Discard the shoe boxes. The same applies to handbags, hats, baseball caps, etc. Place in sealed plastic bags.
- Dresser mirrors should be free from pictures, beads, jewelry, etc. and the dresser tops be clear of colognes, lotions, make-up, nail polish etc. These items can be placed in a plastic bag and placed in the bathroom, even in the bath tub if you run out of room.
- All wall hangings, pictures, posters, etc. should be removed from the walls.
- All cardboard, old newspapers, magazines and similar items in all potentially infested rooms should be discarded.
- Stuffed animals, if heat tolerant should be run thru the dryer as well, and placed in sealed plastic bags. Strongly recommend just discarding altogether. Plastic toys should be wiped down with alcohol and placed in sealed bag.
- Remove all over-the-door shoe bags or jewelry bags and wipe out each pocket with a cloth dampened with rubbing alcohol and place in a sealed plastic bag.
- CD/DVD cases should be vacuumed or wiped down and placed in sealed plastic bags.
- Vacuum all infested rooms twice a day, including the floor, couches, chairs and closet floors. Vacuum bags are to be placed in a sealed plastic bag and discarded. If vacuum has a dust cup, empty outside into a plastic bag and discard. Wash cup out in hot water or wipe the cup with rubbing alcohol.

## Important Notes:

- Discarding of any compromised (ripped/torn) materials or heavily infested items may be required.
- Dismantling of bed frames and other items will be performed by the technician as part of the service program.
- Should the box spring remain, removal of the cheesecloth underside may be required for proper inspection and/or application.
- Zippered mattress/box spring encasements are provided and placed on the beds by the technician at time of treatment. Price is determined by bed size. These encasements must remain on the mattress/box spring for 13 months. Your bed linens can be placed right over the encasements.
- **Do Not**, I repeat, **DO NOT** use any over the counter bed bug sprays, either before, during or after your treatment.
- A clutter-free environment must be provided in order to allow access for the service technician to treat all of the needed areas.
- There will be monitoring devices placed under each foot of the bed(s); do not touch or remove these devices.
- Follow-up inspections of 14 and 30 days are required, the above preparation is only necessary for the initial intensive treatment.
- Before removing all bagged items, do a visual inspection of each item for any pest activity.
